We typically work with specifications, selection and procurement of utility equipment, PFD (Process Flow Diagrams), P&ID (Process & Instrument Diagrams) creation and update and component specifications, but also support other disciplines for example with HVAC (ventilation), EHS (safety), 3D models, quality risk assessments, qualifications and test activities and trouble shooting.
